

TUTORIAL: Installing an iPad App


Installing an app on an iPad first requires a valid Apple ID. An Apple ID is simply a username and password necessary to make any purchases from iTunes or the App Store. If you wish to purchase paid apps, then you must have a credit card or other payment method associated with the Apple ID.



If you only wish to download free apps, then you may create an Apple ID without an associated payment method. To do so follow the instructions at this link:

Note, however, that a credit card or other payment method must be supplied when creating an Apple ID unless you explicitly follow the instructions in the second link. Once you have created an Apple ID, you can install apps from the App Store.



To install an app, the first step is to open the App Store app on your iPad. Tap on this icon to open the App Store.




The app store presents multiple options for discovering apps. Along the bottom of the iPad screen you will see buttons to take you to different parts of the App Store. You can browse and discover apps by looking at the featured section, charts of the top selling apps (which can be sorted by category), and the Genius button, which suggests apps based on those you already have installed.



You may also search for a desired app by name or keyword using the search bar in the top right of the iPad screen.

After finding a desired app, tap on the app's icon to bring up an information screen. From the information screen you can view

details and ratings of the app. This screen is also where you download the app.



To download and install a chosen app, simply tap the small button beside the app indicating the price (either a dollar amount or the word "Free").



For free apps, the button will change from the word free to say "Install App."



For paid apps, the button will change from displaying the price to displaying "Buy App."



If you wish to continue the transaction, then touch the "Install App" or "Buy App" button. At this point, the App Store will ask for your Apple ID and password or just your password if you're already signed in.

Input your Apple ID or Apple ID password and you will see the app begin to download on your home screen. Once the app is downloaded and installed, a smaller "New" banner will appear on the right corner of the app icon. Simply tap on the new icon to launch the app!
